Transition from Year 6 to Year 7

Grade 6 Camp - Mt. Morton 14th Sept - 18th Sept

Interschool Sport

Ongoing communication - Student Diaries

Diaries have been given to all students and we ask that they are checked and signed by parents each week. Students are expected to have the diary with them at school every day. We ask parents/guardians to sign their child's diary each week as it will be checked and signed off by the classroom teacher.
