## **It's not okay to be away**

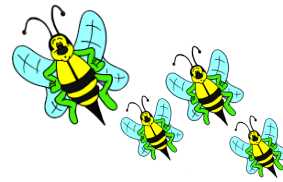
If your child is away or you know will be away please let the school know and also provide a written note upon their return.
