Punctuality

Student Diaries

Most students have been filling in their student diaries diligently and recording their daily reading. We ask that diaries are checked and signed by parents nightly or at least weekly to ensure that students are reading at home regularly. The diaries are also an effective communication tool for teachers and parents. Please feel free to write any questions or concerns in your child's diary at any time. If you need to speak to your child's teacher please request an appropriate meeting time. It is important to remember that problems are usually easier to resolve if they are dealt with promptly.


Homework

Homework this term will begin in week 2 (Monday 13th October) and conclude in week 8 (Friday 5th December). It will be handed out and explained each Monday and will be expected back by Friday for correction. Every classroom has the same homework tasks.

Homework expectations are:

- To read for at least 15 minutes daily and the student diary to be signed by a parent.
- To practise basic spelling skills and strategies.
- To practise basic number skills and strategies.
- To explore fun and engaging educational websites.

Homework should not be stressful or too time consuming. The activities are intended to support what is being done in the classroom and it is valuable for children to complete each task to the best of their ability. If you have any concerns regarding homework, please make an appointment and speak with your child's teacher.



Hats

During Term 1 and Term 4 students are required to wear blue hats (i.e. legionnaire, broad brimmed or bucket hats), whenever they are outside. Students not wearing a hat will be required to play in the courtyard for recess and lunch.

Grade 3 Netbook Information Evening

Our Grade 3 students are beginning to feel very excited about their transition to Grade 4. They know that they will be using their own Netbook computers next year and they will also practice using Netbooks during their Term 4 Transition sessions. An information session will be held for all Grade 3 families to explain how the program works.

Inquiry Unit - Solids, Liquids and Gases

For our Term 4 Inquiry Unit, States of Matter, students will investigate solids, liquids and gasses and how their properties change when heated or cooled. We will learn about the water cycle, make predictions and draw conclusions during exciting experiments and there will also be a focus on what causes heat and how it can be transferred to another source. We will even be experimenting with chocolate! It will be a very fun inquiry unit to end the year.
