

Writers do not always give us every detail and sometimes we have to work out an answer on our own, based on the clues given.</p> <p><b>Activity 1:</b> Read <b>Caroline's Math Test</b> below and complete the questions.</p> <p><b>Activity 2:</b> Read independently for 20 minutes.</p>	<p><b>Task</b></p> <p><b>Focus:</b> Handwriting/Spelling (/or/ as in fork)</p> <p><b>Activity 1:</b> Make a list of words that have the /or/ sound in them.
