Co-ordinators Report

Enrolments for 2017

Soon we will be distributing enrolment forms for 2017.

Regulations require all families to complete a new enrolment form every year along with a new medical plan, medication and risk management plan. If we are not provided with all the required documentation we cannot accept your child's enrolment. Enrolments will be accepted on a first in best dressed basis.

Homework

We provide children with the opportunity to complete their homework at the program every day. However it is not the responsibility of our staff to ensure that your child has completed every task and sign it off. Parents are required to check their child's homework and sign off against it before it is handed in at the end of the week. Our staff will supervise and provide guidance for the children however due to required ratios we cannot have staff working one on one with children to complete their homework.

After School Care Sessions

Currently every Thursday afternoon is FULLY BOOKED. If you require care on a Thursday afternoon please see Joanne or Kate so that we can put your child on a waiting list. Once a spot becomes available we will contact you to let you know. Any requests made with under 24 hours notice will not be accepted.

Additional Reminders:

- Accounts are distributed every Monday and payments are due once a fortnight. Failure to pay accounts on time will result in your child unable to attend the program.
- If your child is not going to be attending the program, please call or text Joanne to inform her. If we are not informed about an absence, you will still be charged the full fees for the session.
- If you are late and your child is collected after 6pm you will be charged a **late fee of \$2 per minute per child**.
