## PHYSICAL EDUCATION

### Task

#### Squash

Squash is generally played with two players, but instead of a net in between you, you are using a wall to hit the ball in between your hits.

#### Equipment:

A ball, a wall and two racquets. If you don't have a racquet, you can play down ball.

#### Instructions:

Hit the ball over the service line, let it bounce on the ground and your opponent will return the ball by hitting it. When somebody cannot return it, a point is scored and there is a new serve.

#### - Level 1 -

Work with your opponent to hit it over the net as many times as you can. A Rally!

#### - Level 2 -

Score points against your opponent.

#### - Level 3 -

Don't let the ball hit the ground.

#### - Level 4 -

Make up your own rules.

#### Winner:

The person who scores the most points.
